
Cornet Adventures: Expanding Your Notes!

Mission: Become a Musical Explorer!

Welcome, Melody Mskers! Today, we're going on a **musical adventure** to discover **new notes** on your cornet. Just like an explorer needs the right tools, you need your **embouchure and tongue** to find the right notes. Let's go!

1. Donkey Sounds: The Eeyore Game!



- **High Notes (G to C on the stave)** Say "**Ee**" (like a donkey's high-pitched call). Feel your tongue lift up? That's what you need for high notes!
- Low Notes (C down to G below the stave) Say "Aw" (like the deep part of a donkey's call). Feel your tongue drop down? That's how to get lower notes!
- Now, try buzzing into your mouthpiece while thinking "Ee" for high and "Aw" for low! Can you match the right sound?

Challenge: Play a short tune using only high "Ee" notes and low "Aw" notes! Can your donkey sing a song?



The challenge? To glide smoothly between notes!

- Start on Middle C and slowly slide down to G below the stave, like a snake slithering down a hill. Use your tongue to guide the sound down (remember: low notes = tongue lower!).
- Now, slither back up to C on the stave, using your tongue to go higher (high notes = tongue up!).
- 3. Try playing it slowly, then faster! Can your snake slither smoothly?

3. Magic Spells: Tongue Power! 🧙 🕂

Why? Your tongue is like a magic wand—it controls the notes!

Say this magic spell: "Tee-Tah-Taw"

- **Tee** = High notes (tongue up!)
- **Tah** = Middle notes (tongue in the middle!)
- **Taw** = Low notes (tongue down!)

Game: Try playing a note while thinking "Tee," then one with "Toh." Can you hear the difference? Now mix them up like a magic spell!

Final Quest: The Echo Game! 🎤

- 1. Ask a friend or teacher to play a note—you must copy it exactly!
- 2. Listen carefully: Is it a high or low note? Adjust your tongue position to match!
- 3. Take turns being the Echo Leader!

Y Super Challenge: Can you echo five notes in a row without looking?
